May I receive copy of Alpine Canada's policy, specifically 4.3.i ?

Below you'll find the email I received from Mr. Dale Sheehan, ITP Sport investigator, Tuesday, May 3rd, 2022 and he refers to Alpine Canada (ACA) policy 4.3.i

I believe when the Federal Government lets publicly funded sports organization's, such as Alpine Canada, write their own policies, there will be a less likely chance of the victim being heard and he/ she will not receive the justice they deserve.

Also attached, a screen shot of an Alpine Canada '100 Years of Excellence' GALA promotion, Nov 6th (Royal York, Toronto) and Nov 7th (Sofatel, Montreal), whereas Nancy Greene, who sexually assaulted me in New Zealand while on a Sun Peaks Resort promotional tour in 2000, her photo is featured on an Alpine Canada poster.

I've copied Ms. Pascale St. Onge, the Federal Minister responsible for Sport.

I hope she will visit my website, <https://tourismsunpeaks.com> as I have created this to help me explain my position and I what I am experiencing personally as a sexual assault survivor.

I have asked numerous people and entities for help with this matter, I have repeatedly been denied help, specifically for sexual assault counselling and I am beginning to feel these people & entities write policies to be unhelpful to victims of sexual assault. I look forward to hearing what you can do to help me address my concerns.

Dear Ryan

Receipt of all of your materials are acknowledged.

The event as described by yourself includes the fact that you were not a member of Alpine Canada at the time of the allegation you and Ms N. Greene Raine attended for a promotional event in New Zealand.

According to your submission, both of you attended as representatives of Sun Peaks Resort and/or Tourism Sun Peak Members.

This event, according to your submission, was sponsored and paid for by Tourism Sun Peaks and there were no contracts or agreements signed with Alpine Canada. According to your submission, Ms Greene's role at the time was assigned by the Executive Director of Tourism Sun Peaks.

Given same, please be advised after a thorough review, there does not appear to be any correlation between the allegation you have filed and Alpine Canada.

Given we are working with current policy, we determine that based on section 4.3.i, a preliminary review was conducted and based on the reasons you have stated in your submissions, determined that it is not admissible according to ACA policies.

Unless there are further submissions that directly link this allegation to the responsibilities you and Ms Greene undertook under the management and direction of Sun Peaks Resort, this matter is not recommended for further investigation by Alpine Canada based on policy.
